

Student Loan Debt Relief

Over **1 million** CNAs and more than **70%** of nursing graduates have federal student loan debt. Nearly **5.06 million** of these workers make up America's senior careforce.

Now, nearly **27 million** people are eligible for federal student loan debt relief, regardless of graduation status or degree type. Find out if you could receive up to **\$20,000** in forgiveness below.

Check Your Eligibility

If you earned less than \$125,000 as an individual or less than \$250,000 as a couple in 2020 and 2021, you may qualify for the following relief amounts:

Did Not Receive a Pell Grant – \$10,000

Received a Pell Grant – \$20,000

Not sure? Log in or create an account on StudentAid.gov to check your loan type and amount. Make sure your loan service provider also has your current contact information.

Fill Out an Application

Applications are available in both English and Spanish. You can access the free application at StudentAid.gov/debt-relief/application.

You will need to include your:

- Legal Name
- Social Security Number
- Date of Birth
- Phone Number
- Email Address

Though you will **not** need to verify your income, you will need to check a box to "certify under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that all of the information provided on this form is true and correct."

The application deadline is December 31, 2023, but we encourage everyone to apply by **November 15, 2022** to have the form processed before the pause on federal student loan payments ends in January.

Beware of Scams



DON'T pay anyone who contacts you with promises of debt relief or loan forgiveness. You will not need to pay anyone to obtain debt relief.



DON'T reveal your FSA ID, account information, or password to anyone who contacts you. The Department of Education and your federal student loan service provider will never call or email you asking for this information.
